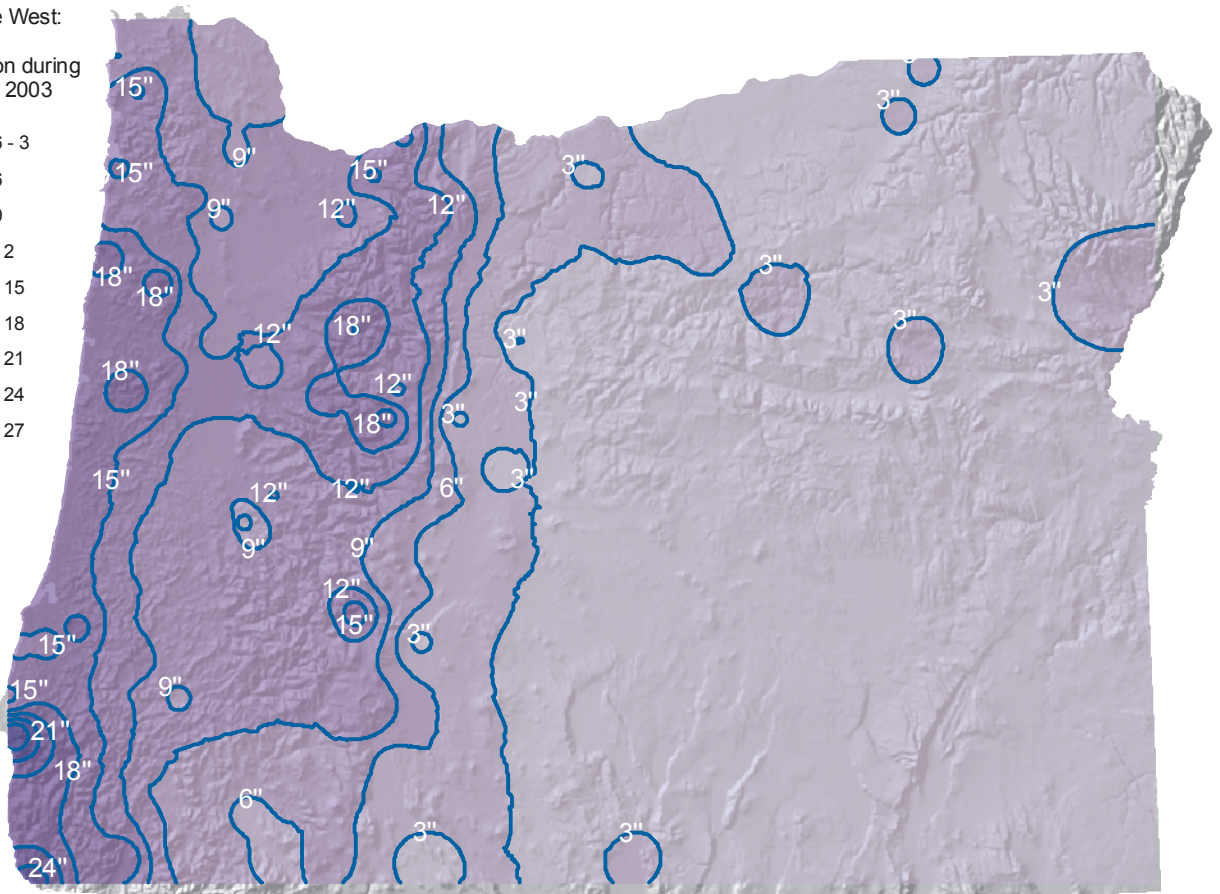
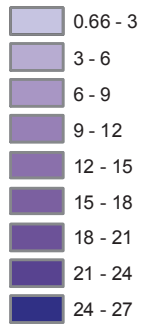


# OREGON: TERRAIN AND PRECIPITATION

Oregon's western coast is dominated by low glaciated peaks, rising to become the foothills of the Cascade Mountain range. Eastern Oregon is characterized by a high, arid plateau of scour lands and scrub. Evergreens such as Douglas Fir are found in the maritime hillsides of western Oregon: east of the Cascades is the domain of sagebrush and scrub oak.
